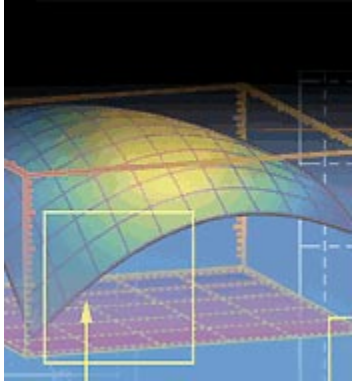




Six Sigma Green Belt Certification Preparation Class



A Six Sigma Green Belt Training Class will be held this fall. The Class will focus on the ASQ Green Belt Body of Knowledge using materials from the Quality Council of Indiana CSSGB Primer and other sources to allow students to prepare for taking the ASQ Green Belt Certification Exam.

This certification review class will consist of 10 weekly sessions beginning September 13th and continuing on Monday nights from 5:30 pm till 8:30 pm at St Joseph's Villa, 8000 Brook Road in Richmond Va. This timing will allow interested participants to sit for the ASQ Green Belt Certification Exam currently scheduled for December 4th. Students will also receive 3.0 RU's for recertification.

The cost for the 10 sessions is \$300.00 for ASQ members and \$350.00 for non members*. This price is significantly lower than other comparable offerings. Enrollment will be limited to the first 20 paid applicants.

Students will also be expected to purchase the *CSSGB Primer* from the Quality Council of Indiana for \$65.00/copy. <http://www.qualitycouncil.com> or 1-800-660-4215. A calculator is also recommended (such as the TI-30X IIS)

Because of the volume and complexity of the material that will be covered, students will be expected to review materials and work problems prior to each class and come prepared to ask questions and discuss what they have read.
